




# MCC Giving Calendar Give the gift of education

<b>Day 1</b> <p>MCC works in some 40 countries around the world. Help support students around the world by <b>giving a nickel</b> for each country in the world you can name.</p>	<b>Day 2</b> <p>Give a quarter to help bring new furniture and playground equipment to schools around the world.</p> 	<b>Day 3</b> <p>Give 15 cents today and read this prayer: "Make me to know your ways, O Lord; teach me your paths." (Psalm 25:4).</p>	<b>Day 4</b> <p>At MCC-supported schools in India, students learn about the importance of clean drinking water and hand-washing. <b>Give two dimes</b> to help students learn to stay healthy.</p>	<b>Day 5</b> <p>Many people use computers and the internet for learning. <b>Give a dime</b> for each computer and smartphone in your home.</p> 
<b>Day 6</b> <p>Your coins help organizations provide tutoring for children in places like Ethiopia. <b>Give four nickels</b> to help.</p>	<b>Day 7</b> <p>According to UNESCO, about 16% of children worldwide are not able to go to school. Ask family and friends to <b>contribute a dime</b> for each year of school that they have completed.</p>	<b>Day 8</b> <p>By <b>giving 15 cents</b> today, you can help students living with disabilities in places like Ukraine get the support they need to thrive in school.</p>	<b>Day 9</b> <p>Eating a good breakfast before you go to school is important. <b>Give 30 cents</b> to help other students eat a good breakfast.</p>	<b>Day 10</b> <p>MCC shares school kits with students in Burundi, including children who are orphans and those living with a disease called HIV. <b>Give 30 cents</b> to help them.</p>
<b>Day 11</b> <p><b>Give two quarters</b> today to support programs that connect parents with their children's schools to improve learning.</p> 	<b>Day 12</b> <p>Children in Cambodia form clubs at their schools to learn how to take care of the environment. You can <b>help by giving 30 cents</b>.</p> 	<b>Day 13</b> <p>Name two subjects or things you enjoy learning about. <b>Give two dimes</b> and thank God for helping you learn.</p>	<b>Day 14</b> <p>MCC works with partners in Bangladesh to provide help with homework. <b>Give a nickel</b> for each hour that you spent doing homework today (or on average).</p> 	<b>Day 15</b> <p>In Rwanda, your coins for MCC help young adults train for jobs so that they can find work. <b>Give a dime</b> to help.</p>



## Day 16

“Teach [God’s words] to your children, talking about them when you are at home and when you are away ...” (Deuteronomy 11:19). Do you have a favorite Bible verse? **Give a quarter** today.

## Day 17

According to UNICEF, 473 million children live in areas of war and violence and need help with their education. **Give two dimes** to help children in areas of conflict attend school.

## Day 18

Who is one of your favorite teachers? Say a prayer of thanks for this special person. **Give 10 cents.**



## Day 19

Millions of children around the world cannot go to school because they have to work to earn money for their family. **Give one dime** for each member of your family.

## Day 20

You can help children in Bolivia learn at after-school programs. **Give 30 cents** today.



## Day 21

Nickels for notebooks. Children around the world use notebooks to do their schoolwork. Search your house and **give a nickel** for each notebook you find.

## Day 22

My coins count! **Give 35 cents** to help bring a bright future for school children and young adults in Lebanon.



## Day 23

According to Action Education, about 14% of adults around the world cannot read or write. **Give 15 cents** to help someone learn.

## Day 24

**Give three nickels** to help young adults in Mozambique learn the skills they need to find jobs.

## Day 25

Make sure students have school supplies and uniforms that they need for school. **Give one nickel** for each outfit you have that you can wear to school.

## Day 26

In countries with high rates of poverty, boys are more likely to go to school than girls. **Give 15 cents** to support girls’ education.

## Day 27

A leadership program in Nepal helps young women learn life-changing skills. **Give a dime** to help them.

## Day 28

The reasons children might not be able to go to school include war, poverty or disasters such as earthquakes. **Give three nickels** today.

## Day 29

Better lunches equal better learning. MCC education programs often provide meals and snacks for students. **Give a quarter** for every meal that you eat today.

## Day 30

“Let the wise also hear and gain in learning ...” (Proverbs 1:5). **Give 25 cents** to support children’s education around the world.
