

Cost Breakdowns for MCC Projects 2021

What can your donations do? This list provides examples of what can be accomplished through small and large donations and everything in between. These are representative of more than 600 projects supported by MCC, and exact costs vary by location and other factors. Costs are listed in U.S. dollars.

Food

- \$10** provides chicks for a family in Cambodia.
- \$10** provides fruit trees for a family in Mexico.
- \$20** stocks one family's pond with fish fingerlings in Cambodia.
- \$25** provides vaccinations for a flock of 25 chickens in Bangladesh.
- \$40** provides a pig for a young adult in Uganda.
- \$41** provides nutrition training and kitchen garden seeds for 10 families in Nepal.
- \$150** helps a farmer in Colombia learn to grow and market cacao, which is made into chocolate.
- \$180** provides a rooftop garden in Palestine.
- \$800** covers the cost of goat-raising workshops for 80 families in Lebanon.

Water

- \$25** provides 20 feet of durable pipe to help bring spring water to a village in India.
- \$70** provides two water filters needed for a well in Mozambique.
- \$80** helps repair a school water system in Jordan.
- \$130** provides a carbon water filter for a school in Nicaragua.
- \$690** provides a pump in one well in Mozambique.
- \$4,000** is the average cost for a new well through MCC water projects around the world.
- \$18,000** builds one complete spring-water system for a village in India.

Education and Training

- \$3** provides a student textbook in Zambia.
- \$5.50** covers the cost of school supplies for a child in countries where MCC provides school kits.
- \$10** helps provide nutritious school meals in Burundi.
- \$50** supplies chalk for a school in Zambia.
- \$150** provides tuition support for one student in Syria.
- \$200** covers the cost of a child's education in Haiti.
- \$250** provides vocational training for one young person in Cambodia.
- \$300** provides a photocopier for a school in Zambia.



Relief

\$30 provides items for one relief kit: (bath soap, shampoo, laundry soap, toothbrushes, bath towels, combs, fingernail clipper, band-aids, sanitary pads).

\$40 provides an emergency food basket for a family in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.

\$75 provides food and comfort for a family in need in Ukraine.

\$85 provides one month of meals for a Venezuelan refugee in Colombia.

\$300 covers the customs fees for one shipment of relief items to Syria.

\$975 covers the weekly cost of meals for 45 Venezuelan refugees, provided by the Mennonite Church of Riohacha, Colombia.

How many items from MCC fit into a shipping container?

1 container of canned meat = 1,000 cartons = 24,000 cans

1 container of relief kits = approximately 2,100 kits

1 container of school kits = approximately 15,000 kits

Peace and Justice

\$20 supports Women Peace Makers in Cambodia.

\$25 provides training for a new peace club member in Nigeria (and in other countries where MCC supports peace clubs).

\$40 supports conflict transformation and human rights work in Mexico.

\$50 helps provide legal aid and hospitality to asylum-seeking and other immigrant families in the United States.

\$75 supports restorative justice and peacebuilding units in correctional facilities in Zambia.

\$100 provides trauma healing for children in South Sudan (and other war-affected countries).

Health

\$15 provides hygiene supplies to help keep a girl in school in Burundi.

\$40 helps to provide nutrition training for mothers in Kenya.

\$50 provides a take-home soap for 50 students in Burundi.

\$70 supports treatment and education about mental health in Nepal.

\$100 is the average cost of a lifesaving latrine in MCC projects around the world.
