Day 1

MCC works in more than 50 countries around the world. Help support students around the world by **giving a penny** for each different country that you can name.

Day 2

Give a quarter to help rebuild schools that are damaged by earthquakes or hurricanes.



Day 3

Give 15 cents today and read this prayer: "Make me to know your ways, O Lord; teach me your paths." (Psalm 25:4).

Day 4

Along with math and reading, students in Kenya learn about hygiene at school. **Give two dimes** to help students learn to stay healthy.

Day 5

Many people use computers and the Internet for learning. **Give a dime** for each computer and smartphone in your home.



Day 6

Your coins help churches provide tutoring for children in places like Honduras. **Give four nickels** to help.



Day 7


According to UNESCO, about one child in five worldwide is not able to go to school. Ask family and friends to **contribute a dime** for each year of school that they have completed.

By giving 15 cents today, you can help children living with disabilities so that they can attend school.

Day 9

Eating a good breakfast before you go to school is important. **Give 30 cents to help other students eat a good breakfast.**



Day 10

Your gifts help pay school and medical fees for children in Burkina Faso who have a disease called HIV. **Give 30 cents to help them.**

Day 11

Give two quarters today to support new programs that connect parents with their children's schools to improve learning.

Day 12

Children in Jordan form clubs at their schools to learn how to take care of the environment. **You can help by giving 30 cents.**

Day 13

Name two things about which you enjoy learning. **Give two dimes** and thank God for helping you learn.





Day 14

MCC works with partners in Bangladesh to provide homework clubs for children. **Give a nickel** for each hour that you spent doing homework today (or on average).

Day 15

In Rwanda, your coins for MCC help young adults train for jobs so that they can find work. **Give a dime to help.**

“Teach [God’s words] to your children, talking about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise” (Deuteronomy 11:19). Do you have a favorite Bible verse? **Give a quarter today.**

Day 17

According to Global Partnership for Education, 75 million children live in areas of war and violence and need help with their education. **Give two dimes** to help children in areas of conflict attend school.

Day 18

Who is one of your favorite teachers? Say a prayer of thanks for this special person. **Give 10 pennies.**



Day 19

Millions of children around the world cannot go to school because they have to work to earn money for their family. **Give one dime** for each member of your family.

Day 20

You can help children in Guatemala learn at after-school programs. **Give 30 cents today.**

Day 21

Pennies for pencils. Children around the world use pencils to do their schoolwork. Search your house and **give a penny** for each pencil you find.



Day 22

My coins count! **Give 35 cents** to help bring a bright future for school children in Bolivia.



Day 23



According to Global Issues Network, one in six adults around the world cannot read or write. **Give 15 cents** to help someone learn.

Day 24

Give three nickels to help young adults in Cambodia learn the skills they need to find jobs.

Day 25

Make sure students have school supplies and uniforms that they need for school. **Give three pennies** for each outfit you have that you can wear to school.



Day 26

In countries with high rates of poverty, boys are more likely to go to school than girls. **Give 15 cents** to support girls’ education.

Day 27

Some women in Afghanistan did not have opportunities to go to school when they were children. Now they are learning to read as adults. **Give a dime to help them.**

Day 28

The reasons children might not be able to go to school include war, poverty or disasters such as earthquakes. **Give three nickels today.**

Day 29

Better lunches equal better learning. MCC education programs often provide meals and snacks for students. **Give a quarter** for every meal that you eat today.



Day 30

“Let the wise also hear and gain in learning ...” (Proverbs 1:5). **Give 25 cents** to support children’s education around the world.
