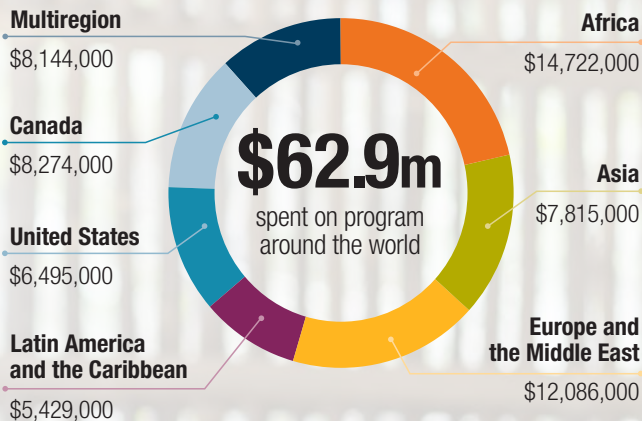
## MCC FINANCIAL INFORMATION
